Signage

3 signs and 4 yard signs have been made with CDC guidelines and if symptoms do not enter . One sign will be at the entrance of the pool. Other 2 signs and 4 other yard signs will be throughout the pool area

We will add signs to the inside of the bathroom to "Wash your hands"

We will add signs to outside of the bathroom to "Limit 2 people at a time in Restroom"

We will have Signs around the pool area "Maintain social distancing"

Board approved the signage plan

Sanitation plan

We have added 4 hand sanitizing stations.

Bathrooms will be cleaned everyday

We will not put out furniture and will add a sign to the "stored" furniture indicating that the furniture is not to be used.

Board approved the sanitation plan

Social Distancing plan

Pool hours will be 8am-9pm

Signage for social distancing will be added

No guests will be allowed at the pool

Waiver

Board voted to have a waiver for residents to sign if residents want access to the pool.

Verbiage will be changed on the waiver to included all adults in the household's signature.

Minors names will be listed. Robin will need to receive the waiver and activate individual resident's key to the pool at a \$5/household cost.
